1. On or about the \_\_\_\_\_, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles served the petitioner with a notice averring that his/her driver's license was being placed under a license suspension as a result of an accumulation of 12 points on his/her driver's license.
2. Petitioner alleges he can show cause why his/her driver's or commercial driver's license or permit or nonresident operating privileges should not be suspended.
3. Petitioner submits there is reasonable cause to believe suspension would seriously affect his ability to continue his employment.
4. Failure to grant stay will cause irreparable harm for which there is no adequate remedy at law in that the petitioner's license cannot be retroactively unsuspended in the event this court subsequently decides the suspension was in error.
5. Petitioner agrees to pay the cost of these proceedings in the event the court fails to find petitioner has shown cause why driving privileges should not be suspended.

WHEREFORE, petitioner asks that this court enter an immediate judgement terminating the administrative license suspension. In the alternative, petitioner asks this court stay the suspension pending a full hearing. Lastly, and also in the alternative, petitioner asks that the court grant him occupational driving privileges during the suspension.
